End of the Year Chapel:

Last day of school:

- *Wednesday, May 29 will be the last day of school for preschool.
- *Wednesday, June 5 marks the last day of school for the year. We will be dismissing at **noon** with normal bus routes right after school. **Reminder:** report cards will be mailed to parents instead of going home with the students.
